Long a champion of public education in the state, Toal advocates social studies through her partnership with US Supreme Court Justice Sandra Day O'Connor's ["Our Courts: 21st Century Civics."](#) This web-based education project is designed to teach students civics and inspire them to be active participants in our democracy.

The first woman to serve as a Justice of the South Carolina Supreme Court, Toal is also the first native Columbian and first Roman Catholic to serve on South Carolina's highest court.
